To the Public.

FATETTEVILLE, N. C., Nov. 26, 1878.

MR. BDITOR,—There is a School House in the town of Fayetteville, known as the Heward School House. Said School House is held by Trustees for the benefit of the Colored People of Fayetteville. In the summer of 1877 the Trustees granted the use of one half of the said School House to the State for a Normal School. The Bishop of the A. M. E. Zion Church, in reporting the action of the Trustees to his Conference, stated that the Trustees had granted the whole building and all of the school apparatus to the State. This was a mistake. The Trustees held a meeting and requested the Bishop to correct his statement. He having failed up to this time to do so, as one of the Trustees of the Heward School House, I take this method of correcting the Bishop's statement, and saying to the people that the Trustees only granted the use of one half of the School Building to the State for two Very respectfully, years.
