Presiding

Dr. T. J. Bryan Chancellor of the university

Even though her parents never finished high school, the importance of receiving an education was always stressed in Dr. T.J. Bryan's home when she was growing up. It was her parents' belief that if one wanted to be successful in life, it would take hard work. Dr. Bryan took those words of wisdom with her each day, knowing if she did what her parents instilled, she would one day see the fruits of her labors. On July 1, 2003, she did. It was on that day that Dr. Bryan was named Chancellor of Fayetteville State University, the second-oldest public university in the Old North State.

That, however, was not the first of Dr. Bryan's many accomplishments. Upon graduation from high school, Dr. Bryan enrolled in Morgan State College in Baltimore, Maryland, as a first-generation student. From a family of meager means, she was concurrently a full-time employee at the National Security Agency and a full-time student. To some, concentrating on academics and holding down a job would seem burdensome but not to Dr. Bryan. She was able to graduate from Morgan State as valedictorian of her class with a degree in English. Realizing she wanted to accomplish more in life, Dr. Bryan went to graduate school at Morgan State, where she earned a master's degree in English. Again, her hard work paid off. As a Ford Foundation National Fellow, she enrolled at the University of Maryland at College Park, where she earned a doctoral degree in English language and literature.

Wanting to share her wealth of knowledge and life experiences with others, Dr. Bryan joined the English faculty at Baltimore's Coppin State College in 1982. There, she amassed many accomplishments. The first was the planning and implementation of a successful honors program. She also established one of the nation's fourteen original Ronald McNair Post-Baccalaureate Achievement programs. Her enthusiasm for encouraging students to excel, her ability to work collaboratively with colleagues and constituents, and her skills in obtaining grants and marshaling resources to achieve goals led to promotions to Department Chair, Dean of the Honors Division, and Dean of Arts and Sciences at Coppin State, where she served through 1998.

By then, Dr. Bryan was quickly becoming a rising star in higher education. Her talents as a scholar, leader, and visionary were becoming known nationwide. In 1998, she was selected by the 13-campus University System of Maryland to become its Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs. In this role, she focused on faculty affairs, academic policy, and educational-equity issues. She is the primary author of **Miles to Go: Maryland** and **The Road Taken**, two works that led to legislation in 2000 and 2001, to creation of a governor's task force, and to the passage of legislation in 2002 that provided a college-intervention program and guaranteed financial assistance to low-income students. She also wrote the 1998 USM minority-achievement plan and was the key architect of the 2001 USM minority-achievement plan.

Dr. Bryan's work with the University of Maryland System did not go unnoticed. In 2002, The Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education recruited her to the position of Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs. She served as chief academic officer and chief student affairs officer for the system, which is composed of the Commonwealth's 14-state-owned universities. In this role, she reviewed all proposals for new academic programs, had oversight for reviews of existing academic and student-support units, developed and revised policies, and managed faculty-development activities. A year later, The University of North Carolina System came calling, enabling Dr. Bryan to achieve what might be the pinnacle of her brilliant career as an educator—Chancellor of FSU.

Over the years, Dr. Bryan has remained committed to scholarly work and community endeavors. In addition to her extensive research on minority-achievement and other higher-education related issues, Dr. Bryan has published and presented widely on early 20th-century African-American women poets. Among her many honors and awards are a National Endowment for the Humanities Fellowship for College Teachers, a Governor's Citation from the State of Maryland, and Citizen of the Year by the Beta Chi Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc. Dr. Bryan is a graduate of the Harvard University Seminar for New Presidents, the Harvard University Management Development Program, the Millennium Leadership Institute, and Leadership Maryland. She is a member of the Wachovia Bank Board of Directors, the Central Intelligence Agency Board of Visitors, and other nonprofit and professional boards.

A native of Maryland, Dr. Bryan is married to Dr. David George Preston, an associate professor in the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science at FSU. They have one son, Bryan David Preston, who is a student at Maryland's Towson University.

Robin Roberts anchors the regular hourly newscasts for ABCNEWS' popular morning show *Good Morning America* from its home base in New York's Times Square. Roberts also serves as an ABCNEWS correspondent, covering a wide variety of stories, and appear as a substitute co-anchor.

Roberts has been a contributor to *Good Morning America* since 1995 and has worked in broadcasting for more than 20 years. While her time has been split between duties at ESPN and ABCNEWS, the majority of her work since 2001 has been with *Good Morning America* and the news division. She also contributes to other ABCNEWS programs, including *World News Tonight* and *20/20*, has served as substitute anchor for *World News Tonight* and as an occasional host of the ABC series *Vanished*.

Roberts has covered a broad range of stories for ABCNEWS and *Good Morning America*, including the practicality of sky marshals on airplanes, how the World Trade Center attacks affected the town of Rockville Center, the custody battle over 12-year-old Timmie Meldrum between two men claiming to be his father, and the gentrification of Harlem. Roberts has also reported on the debate over stem-cell research, Internet adoptions and former President Clinton's first day in Harlem. She has interviewed an impressive array of newsmakers, including Sen. Hillary Rodham Clinton, sports legends Shaquille O'Neal and Tiger Woods and movie stars Samuel L. Jackson and Penelope Cruz. Last year she jetted across the country for *Good Morning America*'s innovative weeklong series, "The X-Treme Urban Challenge." She also covered President George W. Bush's inauguration and the Olympics in both Sydney and Salt Lake City for *Good Morning America*.

Roberts remains a contributor to ESPN, where she has been one of the network's most versatile commentators whose assignments have included hosting *SportsCenter*, contributing to *NFL PrimeTime* from 1990-1994, and providing reports and interviews from the Field. She joined ESPN in February 1990.

At ESPN Roberts worked as play-by-play commentator and host of the network's WNBA (Women's National Basketball Association) games and specials, from 1997-2000. She also anchored *SportsCenter* from major events like Wimbledon, and was the primary reporter for ESPN's coverage of the Winter and Summer Olympics. She served as host of ESPN's prime-time interview program, In the *SportsLight*, ESPN Classic's *Vintage NBA*, provided coverage of the men's NCAA Final Four, the NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament, and of LPGA events. She has also hosted ABC Sports' *Wide World of Sports*.

Beginning in 1988, Roberts worked as a sports reporter and anchor at WAGA-TV in Atlanta and was also a morning personality on WVVE-FM. Prior to working at WAGA, she served as a sports anchor and reporter for WSMV-TV in Nashville, Tenn. (1986-88), where she won the "Nashville Scene" Sportscaster of the Year Award in 1987. She also worked at WLOX-TV in Biloxi, Miss. (1984-86), and WDAM-TV in Hattiesburg, Miss. (1983-84), as a sports anchor and reporter.

In 1983, Roberts graduated cum laude from Southern Louisiana University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in communications. She was also a standout performer on the women's basketball team, ending her career as the school's third-all-time leading scorer (1,446 points) and rebounder (1,034).

The inaugural Robin Roberts Sports Journalism Scholarship, created by the Women's Institute on Sport and Education, was presented at the 1996 NCAA Women's Final Four. In February 1996, Roberts received the annual Distinguished Achievement Award in Broadcasting from the University of Georgia's DiGamma Kappa, the nation's oldest professional broadcasting society. Ebony magazine named her "Outstanding Journalist" at its Outstanding Women in Marketing and Communications Awards. In 2001, she received a President's Award from the Women's Sport Foundation.

Previously, Roberts received the Excellence in Sports Journalism Award for Broadcast Media, given by the Northeastern University Center for the Study of Sport in Society and the School of Journalism. She was awarded the 1992 Women at Work Broadcast Journalism Award for her contributions to the image of working women on television and for expanding career options for women in broadcast journalism. In 1994, she was inducted in the Women's Institute on Sport and Education Foundation's Hall of Fame. Louisiana Public Broadcasting also named her a "Louisiana Legend" for her work.

Roberts, a Mississippi Gulf Coast native, was born in Tuskegee, AL. She currently resides in Manhattan.

Academic Heraldry

American academic attire had its origins in medieval English universities. It was devised to distinguish academic persons such as doctors, licentiates, masters, and bachelors from the lay person, in that everyone wore robes or gowns to ward off the cold. American colleges and universities adopted the wearing of the gown, hood, and cap from the English custom.

The cap, in academic dress, has the same design for all degrees. The tassel that hangs from the center of the cap usually designates the field of study of the wearer. The black tassel is correct for all degrees; however, the gold tassel is worn by doctoral-degree holders.

The gown, unlike the cap, differs considerably in design according to the degree conferred on the wearer. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed at the front. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve. The sleeve base hangs down in the traditional manner. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut and the front point has an arc cutaway. The gown may be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctoral degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is faced down the front with black velvet with three bars of the same across the sleeves or these facings and crossbars may be of velvet or the color distinctive of the subject of which the degree pertains.

The hood for the bachelors degree is three feet in length; for the masters degree, three-and-a-half feet in length; and for the doctoral degree, four feet with panels at the sides. It is lined with the official colors of the university conferring the degree. The discipline of the wearer is indicated by the color of the hood trim.

Historical Sketch

Fayetteville State University

Fayetteville State University was founded in 1867. It began, under the direction of Mr. Robert Harris, as the Howard School with Harris serving as its first principal. Located on Gillespie Street in Fayetteville, the Howard School was erected on land purchased by seven Black men: David A. Bryant, Nelson Carter, Andrew J. Chesnutt, George Grainger, Matthew Leary, Thomas Lomax, and Robert Simmons. In 1877, by legislative action providing for the establishment of a teacher training institution for Black North Carolinians, the Howard School became the first State Colored Normal School and the second-oldest public institution of higher education in the state. In 1907, the institution moved to its current location on Murchison Road. In 1939, the institution was renamed Fayetteville State Teachers College and became a four-year college that received state and regional accreditation in 1947. In 1959, the curriculum was expanded to offer degree programs outside the teaching field. In 1963, the name was changed to Fayetteville State College. In 1969, the name was changed to Fayetteville State University to reflect the institution's legislative designation as a regional institution, and in 1972, FSU became a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina. Today, FSU is a Comprehensive Level I institution offering degrees at the associate's, bachelor's, master's, and doctoral levels. The university serves a growing student body of over 5,000 undergraduate and graduate students, with a full-time faculty of 210.

The University Seal

The seal for Fayetteville State University, commissioned in 1989, was recently redesigned but retained the previous historic symbols. The seal shows the historic Alumni Gates, erected in 1927. Below the gates, the founding year of 1867 is prominently displayed. Between the gates is the Howard School from which the university emerged. An open book depicts the early mission of the university as a teacher preparatory institution, and clasped hands inside the book symbolize unity. Within the banner is the university Motto, "Res Non Verba," Latin for "Deeds, Not Words."

The Chancellor's Medallion

The Fayetteville State University Chancellor's Medallion features the university seal in bronze brushed with gold, surrounded with decorative florets, each of which holds a sparkling blue stone. The medallion's chain echoes the decorative pattern that the seal is couched in, complete with stones in the university's spirit color of royal blue. The seal displays symbols of the university's history. The historic Alumni Gates stand near the main entrance of Fayetteville State University (FSU) on Murchison Road. The gates were donated by alumni and erected in 1927. The gateway symbolizes the university's warm and welcoming nature, and the wrought-iron lamp situated at the center of the arch represents learning and scholarship as lighting the way to success for our students. Below the gates, the founding year of 1867 is prominently displayed. Between the gates is the Howard School, from which the university emerged. An open book depicts the early mission of the university as a teacher preparatory institution, and the clasped hands over the book symbolize the cooperation among races that has enabled FSU to grow and prosper throughout its 138-year history. Within the banner is the university Motto, "Res Non Verba."

The University Mace

The ceremonial mace dates back to ancient Rome, where it honored heroes and nobility. Today, it is used as a symbol of authority. The mace was first adopted at Fayetteville State University in 1986 and has recently been redesigned. During all formal academic processions the mace is carried by the Chief Marshal. Fayetteville State University's Chief Academic Marshal is its Teacher of the Year, who is named annually during Spring Commencement. The university mace is 48" in height with a fluted walnut staff. Adorning the head is the university seal in gold. It is embraced with laurels to mark the spirit of victory. When unattended, the mace stands in a solid walnut and gold base.
