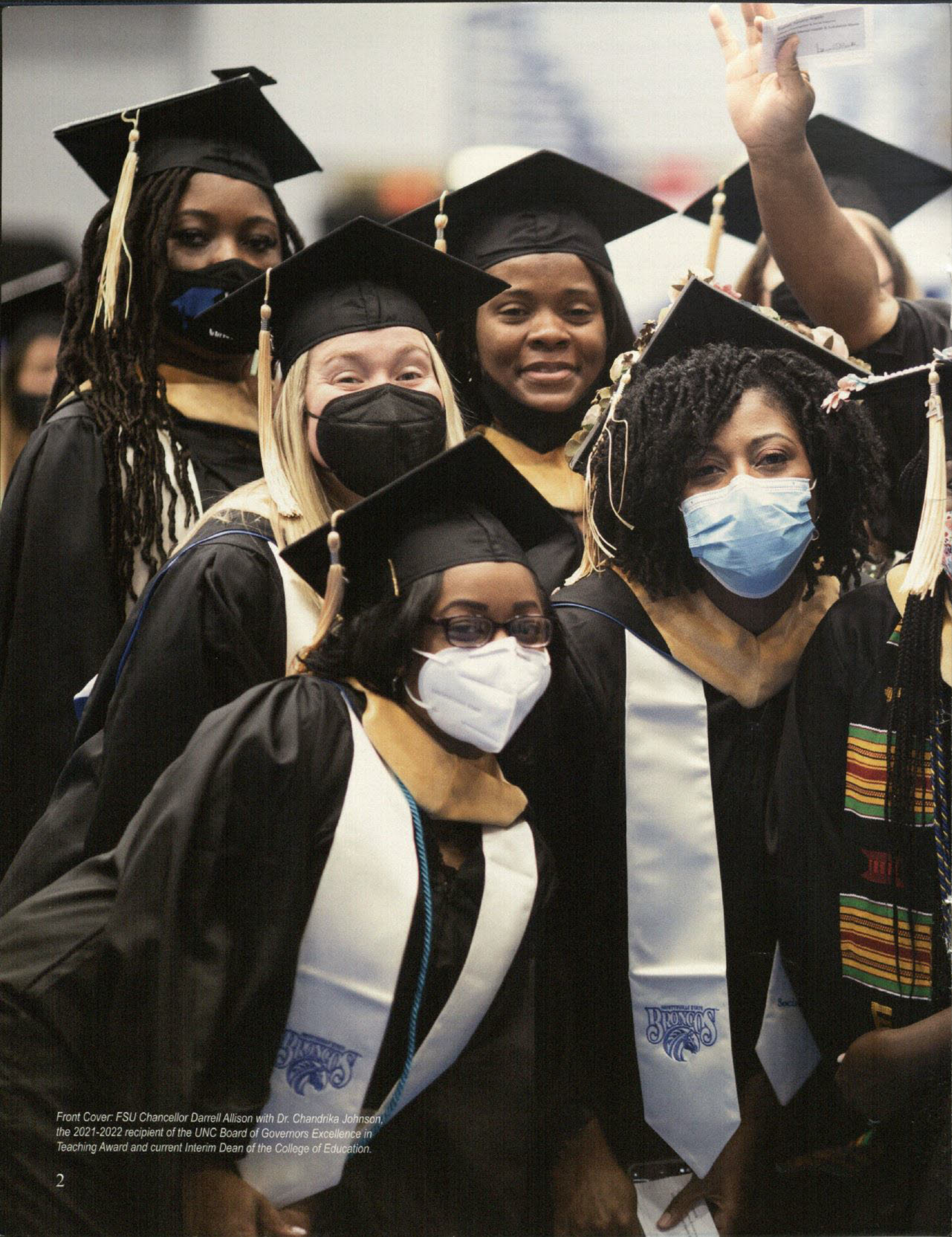

FAYETTEVILLE STATE UNIVERSITY

HISTORICAL PERSPECTIVE

In 1867, seven Black men - Matthew N. Leary, Jr., Andrew J. Chesnutt, Robert Simmons, George Grange, Sr, Thomas Lomax, Nelson Carter, and David A. Bryant - paid \$136 for two lots on Gillespie Street and converted themselves into a self-perpetuating Board of Trustees to maintain this property permanently as a site for the education of Black children in Fayetteville. General O. O. Howard of the Freedman's Bureau, erected a building on this site, and the institution became known as the Howard School. Under the leadership of Robert Harris, the school gained a reputation for its excellence in teaching. By a legislative act of 1877, the North Carolina General Assembly provided for the establishment of a Normal School for the education of Black teachers and the Howard School was selected to become the first State Colored Normal School. Robert Harris was named as Principal. Succeeding him between 1880 and 1899 were Charles W. Chesnutt, Ezekiel E. Smith, George Williams, and Leonard E. Fairley.

In 1899, **Dr. Smith** returned to the institution and in 1908 moved the school to its permanent site on Murchison Road. The school grew from a two-story wooden structure to a physical plant of ten buildings on a fifty-acre tract of land. Smith's title was changed from Principal to President in 1927. Smith's tenure covered a span of fifty years 1883-1933.

Dr. J. Ward Seabrook succeeded Dr. Smith and under his presidency the school became Fayetteville State Teachers College, thereafter being authorized to grant the Bachelor of Science Degree in Elementary Education. The college received both state and regional accreditation in 1947.

Dr. Rudolph Jones was named as President when Seabrook retired in 1956. The curriculum was expanded to include majors in secondary education and programs leading to degrees outside the teaching field. The name of the school was changed to Fayetteville State College in 1963.

In 1969, the institution acquired its present name, "**Fayetteville State University,**" and **Dr. Charles "A" Lyons, Jr.** was elected president. By a legislative act in 1972, Fayetteville State University became a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina System, and Dr. Lyons became its first Chancellor.

On January 1, 1988, **Dr. Lloyd V. Hackley** became the eighth Chief Executive Officer of the University. During his tenure, FSU's master's level programs expanded to include biology, business administration, education, English, history, mathematics, psychology, sociology, and teaching; FSU's first doctoral program in Educational Leadership was established; and, baccalaureate programs increased to include 36 disciplines in the arts and sciences, business and economics, and education.

Dr. Donna J. Benson, Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs of The University of North Carolina, served as FSU's Interim Chancellor from January 1, 1995 to November 15, 1995.

Dr. Willis B. McLeod, a 1964 graduate of Fayetteville State University, became the ninth Chief Executive Officer on November 15, 1995 and was the first alumnus to serve as Chancellor. He expanded academic programs, enhanced athletics and school pride, and expanded collaboration between community colleges, public schools, and FSU.

In July 2003, **Dr. T.J. Bryan** became the first woman elected as Chancellor of FSU. She introduced several new degree programs.

In 2007, **Dr. Lloyd V. Hackley** returned as Interim Chancellor. He introduced a number of organizational changes for greater efficiency of operations and laid the framework for a smooth transition of the new chancellor, Dr. James A. Anderson.

On June 9, 2008, **Dr. James A. Anderson** began his duties as Chancellor of the state's second-oldest public institution. With a Strategic Plan for 2015-2020, and a Capital Campaign for \$25 million, he is moving FSU forward to greatness.

In July 2019, **Dr. Peggy Valentine** assumed the role as Interim Chancellor. During her 18-month tenure, she implemented the 2020-2025 Strategic Plan, focused on enhancing University Communications and secured millions in COVID-19 funding and expanded partnerships with Dell Technologies, Meharry Medical College and the Golden Leaf Foundation.

On February 18, 2021, **Chancellor Darrell T. Allison** was named by the University of North Carolina Board of Governors as the 12th Chancellor of Fayetteville State University.

THE CHANCELLOR'S MEDALLION

The Fayetteville State University Chancellor's Medallion features the university seal in bronze brushed with gold, surrounded with decorative florets, each of which holds a sparkling blue stone. The medallion's chain echoes the decorative pattern that the seal is couched in, complete with stones in the university's spirit color of royal blue. The seal displays symbols of the university's history. The historic Alumni Gates stand near the main entrance of Fayetteville State University (FSU) on Murchison Road. The gates were donated by alumni and erected in 1925. The gateway symbolizes the university's warm and welcoming

nature, and the wrought-iron lamp situated at the center of the arch represents learning and scholarship as lighting the way to success for our students. Below the gates, the founding year of 1867 is prominently displayed. Between the gates is the Howard School, from which the university emerged. An open book depicts the early mission of the university as a teacher preparatory institution, and the clasped hands over the book symbolize the cooperation among races that has enabled FSU to grow and prosper throughout its history. Within the banner is the university Motto, "Res Non Verba." Latin for "Deeds, Not Words."

THE UNIVERSITY SEAL

The seal for Fayetteville State University, commissioned in 1989, was recently redesigned but retained the previous historic symbols. The seal shows the historic Alumni Gates, erected in 1925. Below the gates, the founding year of 1867 is prominently displayed. Between the gates is the Howard School from which the university emerged. An open book

depicts the early mission of the university as a teacher preparatory institution, and clasped hands inside the book symbolize unity. Within the banner is the university Motto, "Res Non Verba," Latin for "Deeds, Not Words."

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

The ceremonial mace dates back to ancient Rome, where it honored heroes and nobility. Today, it is used as a symbol of authority. The mace was first adopted at Fayetteville State University in 1986 and has recently been redesigned. During all formal academic processions the mace is carried by the Chief Marshal. Fayetteville State University's

Chief Academic Marshal is its Teacher of the Year, who is named annually during Spring Commencement. The university mace is 48" in height with a fluted walnut staff. Adorning the head is the university seal in gold. It is embraced with laurels to mark the spirit of victory. When unattended, the mace stands in a solid walnut and gold base.



DARRELL T. ALLISON

CHANCELLOR OF THE UNIVERSITY



Darrell T. Allison is the 12th chief executive officer and chancellor of Fayetteville State University, the second-oldest public university in the UNC System. He has led FSU to numerous achievements and accolades and has positioned the university for even greater influence and impact. A responsive and results-driven leader, Chancellor Allison has also bolstered stakeholder and community engagement, with benefits accruing to the university and the broader Sandhills region.

During his tenure at FSU, Chancellor Allison has worked successfully to boost institutional resources, leading to widespread campus enhancements and improvements. In 2021, he led FSU to an historic \$164 million state budget appropriation that will strengthen institutional infrastructure and programs for years to come. Funds are enabling a multi-year campus revitalization effort and include extensive repairs and renovations as well as construction of new residence halls, a College of Education building, and parking deck. Other campus revitalization efforts include moving the University Health and Wellness Center to campus and establishing the Bronco One Stop, which centralizes student services in one convenient on-campus location.

Another key focus area for Chancellor Allison has been improving college affordability and access in order to maximize student success. He secured FSU's participation in the NC Promise Tuition Plan, which leverages state dollars to subsidize the cost of tuition for all enrolled students, and he used COVID relief funding to clear \$1.6 million in student debt, amassed during the pandemic. His 30-60-90 Summer School Program has provided scholarships to FSU students for summer school classes, with the goal of optimizing their on-time graduation.

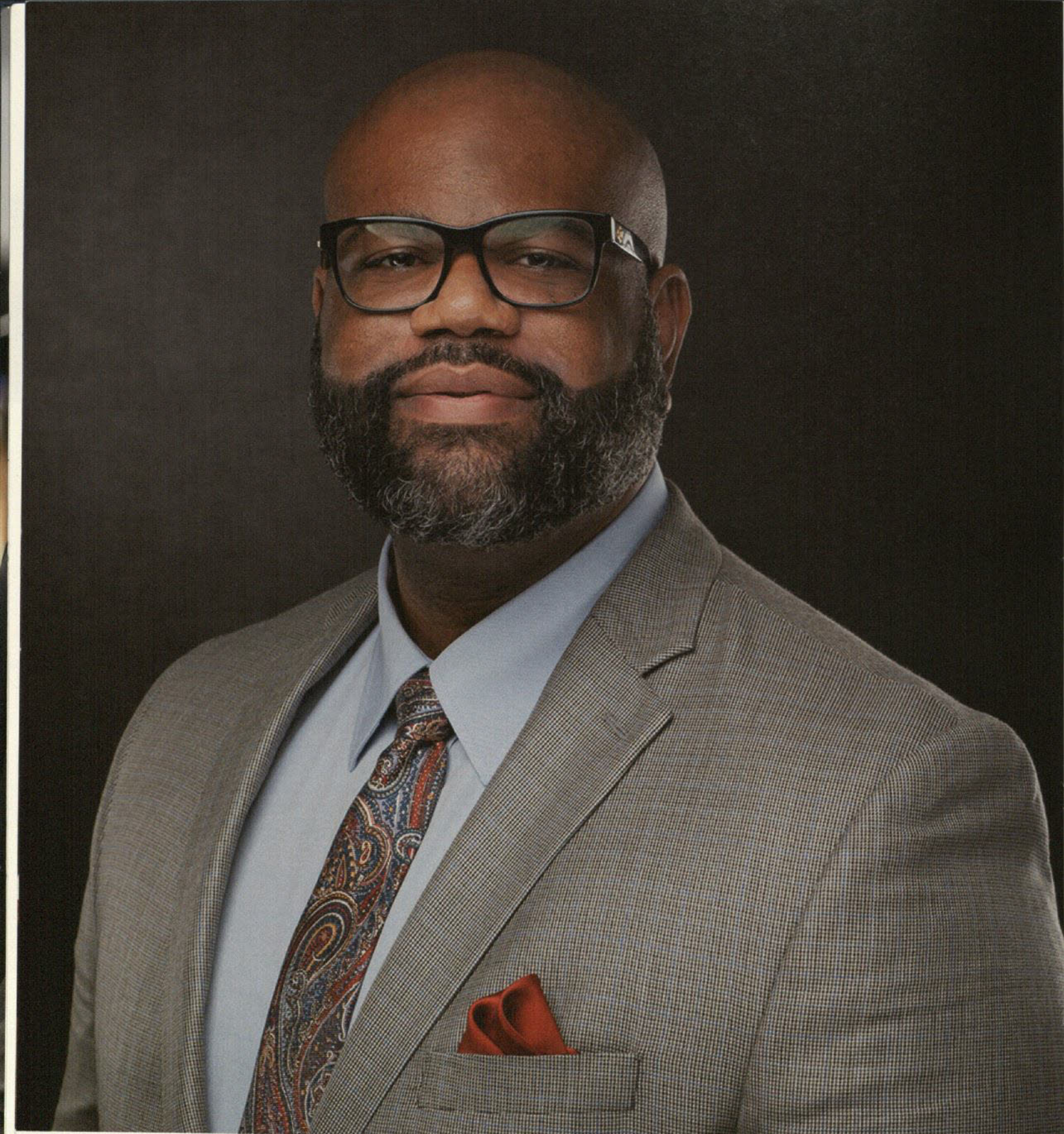
Chancellor Allison is also working to broaden FSU's reach with targeted student populations, providing more effective outreach, services, and resources to adult learners and military-connected students. His efforts have helped position FSU as a national leader with military-connected students. In 2021, FSU was the top-ranked "Best for Vets" college among all four-year HBCUs in Military Times' annual ranking. The Military Order of the Purple Heart has also designated FSU as a Purple Heart University, in recognition of FSU's support of veterans and their families. FSU is the first of 16 UNC System schools to receive this honor.

In addition to strengthening institutional infrastructure and programs, Chancellor Allison is building stakeholder engagement and deepening FSU's community impact. During his first year in office, he raised over \$2 million in private philanthropy support from key university stakeholders. A known bridge-builder, Chancellor Allison has also established important community partnerships and investments. He negotiated the debt-free acquisition of Bronco Square, which includes space to support small businesses and local entrepreneurs and will serve as an engine for enterprise in the Fayetteville area.

Chancellor Allison's career as a transformational leader in education spans several decades and has included advocacy for historically underserved students at both the state and national level. Prior to his appointment as chancellor, he served as the vice president for governmental affairs and state teams at the American Federation for Children, working to expand educational opportunity for disadvantaged students nationwide. During his 2017-20 tenure on the UNC Board of Governors, he chaired the Board's inaugural Historically Minority-Serving Institutions (HMSI) Committee, advocating successfully for more equitable funding for HMSIs as well as programming and research dollars for these schools. In addition, he served on a number of other key committees, driving support for multi-million-dollar technology upgrades, and ushering in cost savings. He was also tapped to chair the UNC System's inaugural Racial Equity Task Force.

Earlier governance experience has encompassed service on the North Carolina Central University (NCCU) Board of Trustees as well as the NCCU Chancellor Search Committee. In 2017, Chancellor Allison endowed a scholarship fund at NCCU in honor of his late father, Thomas Allison.

A North Carolina native, Chancellor Allison holds a Juris Doctor degree from UNC-Chapel Hill and a bachelor's degree from NCCU. He and his wife La Nica are the proud parents of two daughters.

KEYNOTE SPEAKER

On Aug. 6, 2021, entrepreneur and philanthropist Nicholas Perkins closed a historic deal to acquire the Fuddruckers restaurant franchise system from Houston-based Luby's, Inc., in a transaction valued at \$18.5 million.

The purchase by Perkins, 41, encompassed ownership of the Fuddruckers brand worldwide, to include eateries in Canada, Mexico, Panama and the United States. Perkins had previously acquired 14 U.S. Fuddruckers franchises, making him one of the chain's major franchisees.

He created Black Titan Franchise Systems, LLC, to serve as an operating company for Fuddruckers, with 'Black Titan' paying homage to legendary African American businessman A.G. Gaston.

Born and raised in Fayetteville, North Carolina, Perkins owns and operates several food-industry companies and is a board member of the National Urban League. An alumnus of Fayetteville State University, who later earned an MBA from Howard University, Perkins has donated millions of dollars toward HBCU scholarships over the past 11 years.

Reared in a single-parent household, with assistance from his maternal grandmother, Perkins is committed to creating employment opportunities within the African American community.

As an elementary school student, Perkins always carried a note pad to jot down unfamiliar words he encountered while reading. That made it a simple matter to look the words up the next time Perkins was near a dictionary.

Another Perkins quirk during elementary school was his habit of cutting pictures of lavish homes and luxury automobiles from magazines. He'd then paste the images onto a vision board that Perkins basically viewed as a roadmap for his future.

"I have always been a dreamer," Perkins relates. "My course has been communicated to me through my vision, my dream, my passion and through my faith. All the work I do, I believe, I have been destined to do."

When he was just 24, Perkins created the Perkins Management Company, a North Carolina firm that specializes in providing contract-food services.

"I'm thrilled to have purchased Fuddruckers and look forward to working with its many dedicated, highly capable franchisees to further build this brand," Perkins says of his newest business endeavor. Within a month of acquiring Fuddruckers, Perkins opened a restaurant at Benedict College, an HBCU located in Columbia, South Carolina.

It marks the first time in Fuddruckers' 42-year history that the brand has been on a college campus.
