Dr. Willis B. McLeod
Chancellor of the University

Appointed Chancellor of Fayetteville State University in 1995, Dr. Willis B. McLeod brings to his alma mater over 30 years of professional experience in the field of education. He is the ninth chief executive officer of the 133-year-old institution, and the first alumnus Chancellor since Fayetteville State University became a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina in 1972.

Several major initiatives have been established by Dr. McLeod. A new "Freshman Year Initiative," designed to enhance students' educational outcomes, was put in place in fall 1996; new outreach efforts aimed at building stronger community ties and involving the community in university life have been undertaken; several campus improvement projects, such as expansion of the Rudolph Jones Student Center, and university apartments have been completed; and plans for a shopping center are in progress. Dr. McLeod has also been instrumental in forming a regional partnership of public school, community college, and university leaders to focus on strengthening the educational pipeline from pre-school to post-graduate studies. He serves on the President's Advisory Council on HBCUs; the Fayetteville Area Economic Development Corporation Board; the Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce; the Cumberland County Education Foundation; the Wachovia Bank Advisory Board of North Carolina; the Executive Board of the Occoneechee Council of Boy Scouts of America; and the Board of Directors of Operation Sickle Cell, Inc.

Awards received by Dr. McLeod include the NAFEO Distinguished Alumni Award; the NAFEO Board of Directors; Man of the Year, RISE; and Motivator of the year, HORIZON.

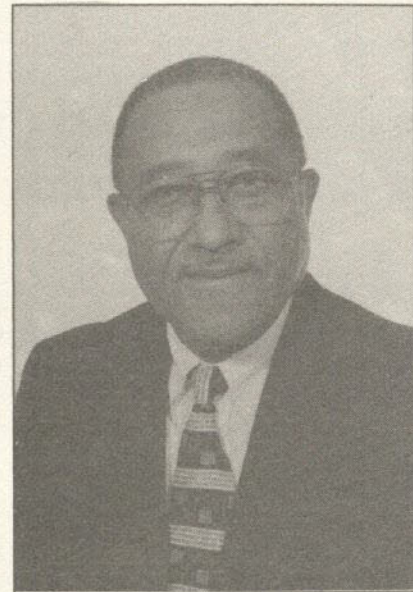
He is a lifetime member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity and one of the founders of FSU's Epsilon Beta Chapter. Other professional and civic organizations in which he holds memberships are the National Alliance of Black School Educators, the American Association of School Administrators, the Black Family Summit Planning Committee, Cape Fear Chapter of 100 Black Men of America, Inc., Life Member of the NAACP, and he is a member of First Baptist Church in Fayetteville.

A native of Dunn, North Carolina, Dr. McLeod began his career as a mathematics teacher in Richmond, Virginia and his career has spanned through the ranks of Principal to Superintendent, to Chancellor of his alma mater. He earned a B.S. Degree in Mathematics from Fayetteville State University and the M.Ed. Degree in Elementary School Administration and Ed.D. in School Administration from the University of Virginia in Charlottesville, Virginia. He is married to Jacqueline Cumbo McLeod and has one son, Jeffrey, who is an FSU graduate.

Chief Justice Henry Frye

Chief Justice Henry E. Frye is a native of Ellerbe in Richmond County. He graduated as valedictorian from Mineral Springs High School in Ellerbe, and Summa Cum Laude from North Carolina A&T State University, Greensboro, with a major in biology and a double minor in chemistry and air science. He also graduated with honors from the UNC-Chapel Hill School of Law. Frye was commissioned as 2nd Lieutenant in the United States Air Force Reserve and later became Captain. He served as an Ammunition Officer in Japan and Korea.



He was the organizer and President of Greensboro National Bank, Greensboro. He practiced law in Greensboro for 21 years and was admitted to the Federal District, Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals and the United States Supreme Court. He holds an impressive list of firsts for the state. In 1968, he became the first African-American to serve in the North Carolina House of Representatives in the Twentieth Century. He later gained a seat in the North Carolina Senate. In 1983, he became the first African-American to serve on the Supreme Court of North Carolina. In 1999 he was appointed by Governor Jim Hunt to serve as Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.

Frye's distinguished service to North Carolina has brought him commendations and awards from organizations across the state. He received the UNC-Chapel Hill's Distinguished Alumnus Award and the North Carolina A&T State University Alumni Excellence Award. He received the Doctor of Laws from both Shaw University and North Carolina A&T. The University of North at Greensboro presented him the Charles D. McIver Medal. He was also named the Lawyer of the Year by the Association of Black Lawyers and later received the North Carolina Academy of Trial Lawyers' Appellate Judges Award. He is past chairman of the Board of the American Judicature Society. The National Conference of Christians and Jews presented him the Brotherhood Award, and the North Carolina NAACP chose him to receive its Kelly M. Alexander Humanitarian Award.

Chief Justice Frye is a deacon and former Sunday School teacher at Providence Baptist Church, Greensboro. He and his wife, Shirley T. Frye, have two sons, Judge Henry E. Frye, Jr., and Harlan Frye.

Mr. Joel A. Smith, III
Dean, The Darla Moore School of Business

Mr. Joel A. Smith, III is currently Dean of The Darla Moore School of Business at The University of South Carolina, Columbia, South Carolina. He was formerly the President of Bank of America East, responsible for the administration and management of the Commercial Small Business, Professional and Executive, and Consumer Banking divisions in seven states and the District of Columbia.

Mr. Smith joined the bank in 1971. He has held positions as a credit analyst, commercial loan officer, senior loan and credit officer, city executive and area executive. He also has served as a regional executive and president of the Carolinas.

A native of Columbia, South Carolina, he graduated from the University of the South in Sewanee, Tennessee, the National Commercial Lending School at the University of Oklahoma and the School of Banking of the South at Louisiana State University. Mr. Smith served in the United States Navy from 1967 to 1971 and in the United States Naval Reserve from 1971 to 1987, where he retired as commander.

Mr. Smith serves on the boards of the South Carolina Accountability Oversight Committee, the Governor's School for Mathematics and Science Foundation, the Palmetto Foundation, the South Carolina Business Center for Excellence in Education, the Central Carolina Community Foundation, the Presidential Advisory Board of Benedict College, and the Board of Regents of the University of the South, Sewanee, Tennessee. He serves as chairman of the University of South Carolina Business Partnership Foundation, Spoleto Festival USA, and the Board of Trustees of the South Carolina Foundation of Independent Colleges and Universities. In addition, he is a member of the Board of Visitors of the Columbia Museum of Art.

During his career, he has received numerous awards and recognitions. To name a few, in 1997, he was named the South Carolina Economic Development Volunteer of the Year, the International Ambassador of the Year, the "Tree of Life" award from the National Jewish Fund, and received an Honorary Degree from South Carolina State University. In 1994, he received the Businessman of the Year Award from the South Carolina Chamber of Commerce.

Mr. Smith and his wife, Kathryn, have three children and they live in Columbia, South Carolina.

ACADEMIC HERALDRY

American academic attire had its origins in medieval English universities. It was devised to distinguish academic persons such as doctors, licentiates, masters and bachelors from the lay person, in that everyone wore robes or gowns to ward off the cold. The wearing of the gown, hood and cap was adopted by American colleges and universities from the English custom.

The cap, in academic dress, has the same design for all degrees. Mortarboards are generally recommended, although soft square-topped caps are permissible. The tassel that hangs from the center of the cap usually designates the field of study of the wearer. The black tassel is correct for all degrees; however, the gold tassel is worn by doctors.

The gown, unlike the cap, differs considerably in design according to the degree conferred on the wearer. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves. It is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the masters' degree has an oblong sleeve. The sleeve base hangs down in the traditional manner. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut and the front point has an arc cutaway. The gown may be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is faced down the front with black velvet with three bars of the same across the sleeves or these facings and crossbars may be of velvet or the color distinctive of the subject of which the degree pertains.

The hood for the bachelor's degree is three feet in length; for the master's degree, three and a half feet in length; and for the doctoral degree, four feet with panels at the sides. It is lined with the official colors of the university conferring the degree. Also, the discipline of the wearer is indicated by the colors in the hood.

HISTORICAL SKETCH

Fayetteville State University

Fayetteville State University was founded in 1867 on Gillespie Street as the Howard School by seven Black men: David A. Bryant, Nelson Carter, Andrew J. Chesnutt, George Grainger, Matthew Leary, Thomas Lomax, and Robert Simmons. In 1877, by legislative action providing for the establishment of a teacher training institution for Black North Carolinians, the Howard School became the first State Colored Normal School and the second-oldest public institution of higher education in the state. In 1907, the institution moved to its current location on Murchison Road. In 1939, the institution was renamed Fayetteville State Teachers College, and became a four-year college that received state and regional accreditation in 1947. In 1959, the curriculum was expanded to offer degree programs outside the teaching field. In 1963, the name was changed to Fayetteville State College. In 1969, the name was changed to Fayetteville State University to reflect the institution's legislative designation as a regional institution, and in 1972, FSU became a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina. Today, FSU is a Comprehensive Level I institution offering degrees at the associate's, bachelor's, master's and doctoral levels. The university serves a growing student body of over 4,000 undergraduate and graduate students, with a full-time faculty of 210.

THE UNIVERSITY SEAL

The current seal for Fayetteville State University was commissioned in 1989 for the installation of the university's eighth Chief Executive Officer. The seal shows, at one entrance to the university, the historic Alumni Memorial Gates, erected in 1925. Above the gates, the founding year of 1867 is prominently displayed. Between the gates is the Howard School from which the university emerged. An open book depicts the early mission of the university as a teacher preparatory institution and clasped hands inside the book symbolize unity. Within the banner is the university Motto, Res Non Verba, "Deeds, Not Words." The gates are joined at the bottom by laurels to mark the spirit of victory and pine cones to typify the North Carolina landscape. Two lamps of learning adorn the outer edges of the seal and represent the University's mission to impart learning to all who enter.

THE CHANCELLOR'S MEDALLION

The three-inch Chancellor's Medallion is a gold replica, cast in bronze, of the seal for Fayetteville State University. The medallion worn by Chancellor McLeod commemorates his installation and bears his name and the September 20, 1996, date. As part of the official academic dress for the Chancellor, it is to be worn at all ceremonial occasions.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

Originally, the mace was modeled after war clubs carried into battle by 12th century officers. Today, it is used as a symbol of authority. Borne by the chief marshal in all university academic processions, the mace was first adopted at Fayetteville State University in 1986 and redesigned in 1989 to reflect the new seal. It was used for the first time during the 1989 Commencement exercises. The university mace is 40" in length with a cylinder-shaped head cast in hollow brass which bears the university's name, founding year and motto. Adorning the head is the university seal. Embracing the seal are laurels to mark the spirit of victory. Mounted on two sides and at the top of the cylinder are spiral rings that can be seen on the Alumni Memorial Gates. Supporting the polished brass cylinder is a 13" walnut staff tipped with a 3 ½" solid brass ball. When unattended, the mace stands in a solid walnut base.

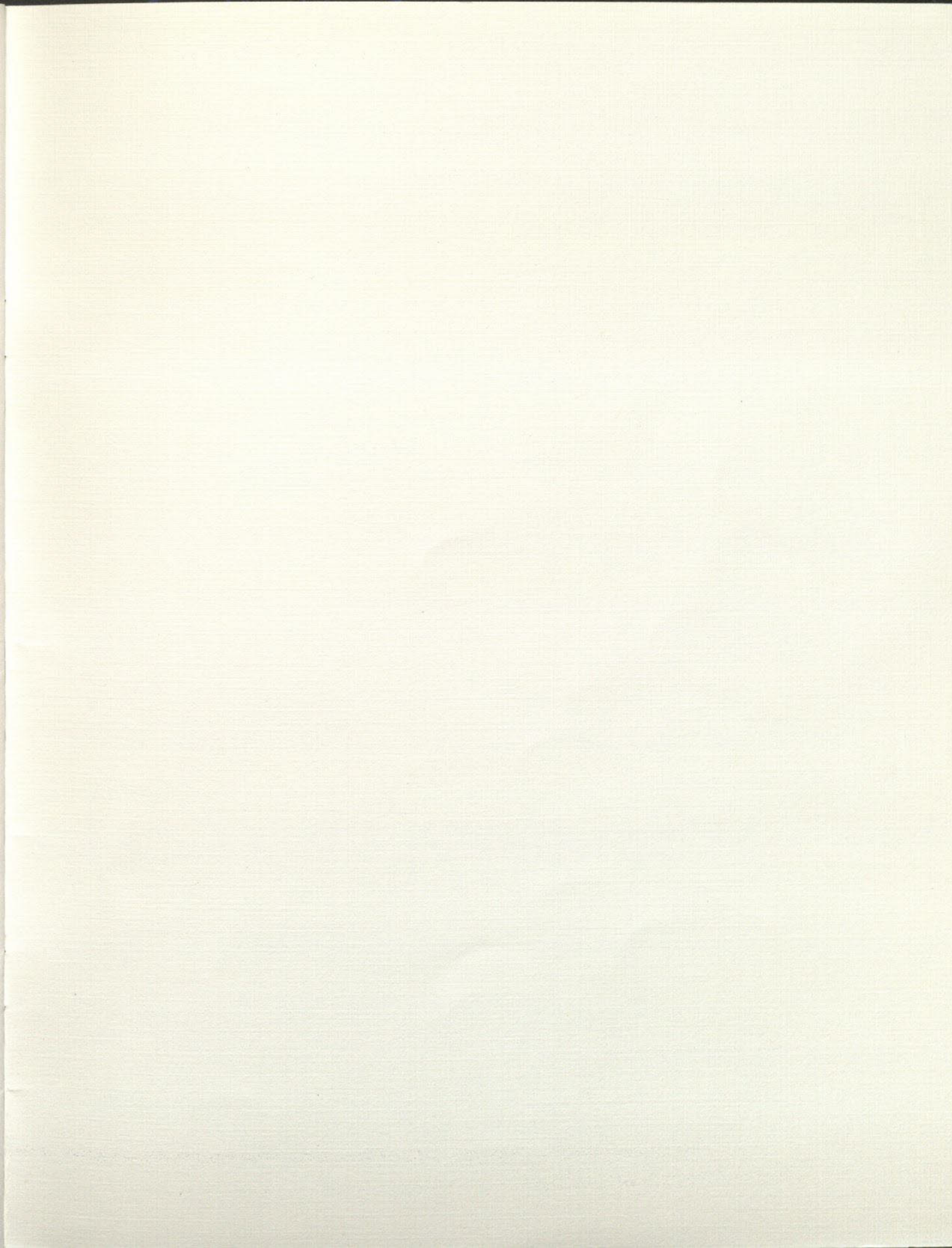
