HISTORICAL SKETCH

Fayetteville State University

Fayetteville State University was founded in 1867 on Gillespie Street as the Howard School by David A. Bryant, Nelson Carter, Andrew J. Chesnutt, George Grainger, Matthew Leary, Thomas Lomax, and Robert Simmons. In 1877, by legislative action providing for the establishment of a teacher training institution for Black North Carolinians, the Howard School became the first State Colored Normal School and the second-oldest public institution of higher education in the state. In 1907, the institution moved to its current location on Murchison Road. In 1939, the institution was renamed Fayetteville State Teachers College, and became a four-year college that received state and regional accreditation in 1947. In 1959, the curriculum was expanded to offer degree programs outside the teaching field. In 1963, the name was changed to Fayetteville State College. In 1969, the name was changed to Fayetteville State University to reflect the institution's legislative designation as a regional institution, and in 1972, FSU became a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina. Today, FSU is a Comprehensive Level I institution offering degrees at the associate's, bachelor's, master's and doctoral levels. The university serves a growing student body of over 4,000 undergraduate and graduate students, with a full-time faculty of 210.

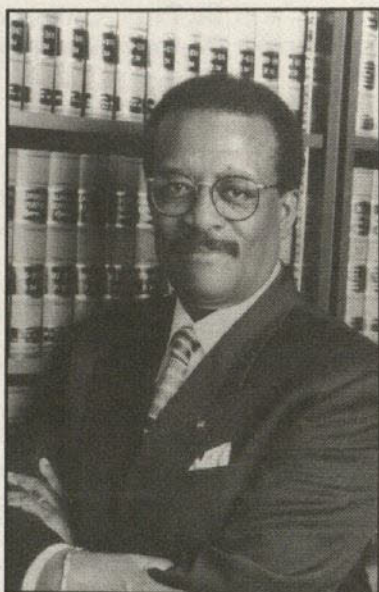
Appointed Chancellor of Fayetteville State University in 1995, Dr. Willis B. McLeod brings to his alma mater over 30 years of professional experience in the field of education. He is the ninth chief executive officer of the 133-year-old institution, and the first alumnus Chancellor since Fayetteville State University became a constituent institution of The University of North Carolina in 1972.

Several major initiatives have been established by Dr. McLeod. A new "Freshman Year Initiative," designed to enhance students' educational outcomes, was put in place in fall 1996; new outreach efforts aimed at building stronger community ties and involving the community in university life have been undertaken; several campus improvement projects, such as expansion of the Rudolph Jones Student Center, have been completed; and plans for a shopping center and university apartments are in progress. Dr. McLeod has also been instrumental in forming a regional partnership of public school, community college, and university leaders to focus on strengthening the educational pipeline from pre-school to post-graduate studies. He serves on the President's Advisory Council on HBCUs; the Fayetteville Area Economic Development Corporation Board; the Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce; the Cumberland County Education Foundation; the Wachovia Bank Advisory Board of North Carolina; the Executive Board of the Occoneechee Council of Boy Scouts of America; and the Board of Directors of Operation Sickle Cell, Inc.

Awards received by Dr. McLeod include the NAFEO Distinguished Alumni Award; the NAFEO Board of Directors; Man of the Year, RISE; and Motivator of the year, HORIZON.

He is a lifetime member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity and one of the founders of FSU's Epsilon Beta Chapter. Other professional and civic organizations in which he holds memberships are the National Alliance of Black School Educators, the American Association of School Administrators, the Black Family Summit Planning Committee, Cape Fear Chapter of 100 Black Men of America, Inc., Life Member of the NAACP, and he is a member of First Baptist Church in Fayetteville.

A native of Dunn, North Carolina, Dr. McLeod began his career as a mathematics teacher in Richmond, Virginia and his career has spanned through the ranks of Principal to Superintendent, to Chancellor of his alma mater. He earned a B.S. Degree in Mathematics from Fayetteville State University, and the M.Ed. Degree in Elementary School Administration and Ed.D. in School Administration from the University of Virginia in Charlottesville, Virginia. He is married to Jacqueline Cumbo McLeod and has one son, Jeffrey, who is an FSU graduate.

*Mr. Johnnie L. Cochran, Jr.
Attorney At Law*

Attorney Johnnie L. Cochran, Jr. was born in Shreveport, Louisiana, on October 2, 1937. His family moved to California in 1943 and eventually to Los Angeles in 1949, where he has since resided. He was graduated from Los Angeles High School prior to entering the University of California at Los Angeles, where he received his B. S. degree in Business Administration. Mr. Cochran received his J. D. degree from Loyola University School of Law on June 17, 1962, and became a member of the California Bar on January 10, 1963. Thereafter, he did graduate work in law at the University of Southern California. He was licensed to practice law in the Western District of Texas in October 1966, and was admitted to practice before the United States Supreme Court in October 1968.

Mr. Cochran served as Deputy City Attorney for the City of Los Angeles, assigned to the Criminal Division, from January 1963 until April 1965. In 1966, he founded the Law Firm of Cochran, Atkins & Evans, and developed a practice handling a substantial volume of both civil and criminal cases. He earned a reputation as an outstanding trial lawyer, culminating in his being named the 1977 Criminal Trial Lawyer of the Year by the Los Angeles Criminal Courts Bar Association.

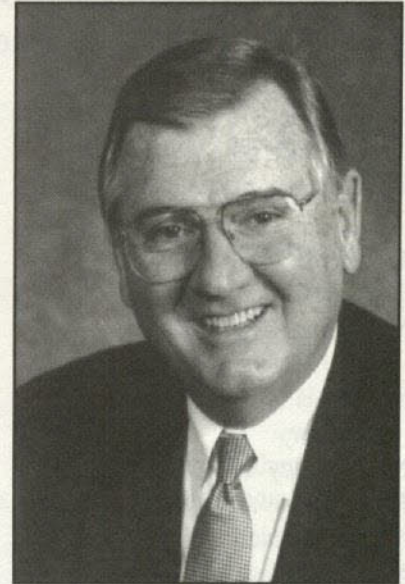
From 1978 through 1980 Mr. Cochran served as the Assistant District Attorney of Los Angeles County. As the Assistant District Attorney, he was the third-ranking lawyer in the nation's largest law office; he had general administrative responsibility for the six hundred lawyers in the office and had specific responsibility for more than eighty-five lawyers assigned to the Juvenile, Special Investigations, and Consumer and Environmental Protection Divisions, and the Sexual Crimes Unit. The Special Investigations Division investigates all allegations of government corruption, including police shootings.

Attorney Cochran has been involved with numerous professional, educational, and public service activities and organizations at the local, state, regional, and national levels. A few of them include the following: Founding Chairperson of the Domestic Violence Council of Los Angeles County (1979); adjunct Professor of Law at the UCLA School of Law, as well as at Loyola University School of Law and Harvard; Legal Counsel and active member of Second Baptist Church; recipient (1982) of the largest jury verdict (at that time) in the history of the City of Los Angeles, in a police abuse case (\$1.3 million); guest attorney on the NBC Television Program, "Headlines on Trial"; Board of Trustees of the Children's Institute International; named one of Southern California's "Outstanding Criminal Defense Attorneys" by the Los Angeles Times Magazine; president of the Black Business Association of Los Angeles, California (1989); Fellow of the American Bar Foundation (1991); named one of the ten most successful litigators in the country in The National Law Journal (1992); recipient of prestigious Golden Bell Award (1994); retained as Special Legal Counsel for NBC News, with Tom Brokaw, regarding the O. J. Simpson Preliminary Hearing; recipient of honorary doctorates from Florida Memorial College, Claflin College, Howard University, Central State University, and Delaware State University; recipient of the 100 Black Men's Annual President's Award; author of *Journal to Justice*, an autobiography (1996); co-founder of The Johnnie L. Cochran, Jr. Art Fund, Inc.; admitted to the Bar of the State of California, the District of Columbia, and the State of New York; and has addressed and lectured audiences across the country.

He resides in Los Angeles with his wife, Dr. Dale Mason Cochran, and his father, Johnnie L. Cochran, Sr. He also resides in New York City. He has three children: Melodie, Tiffany, and Jonathan.

The Honorable Anthony (Tony) Rand
North Carolina Senator



The Honorable Anthony (Tony) Rand began his long and distinguished career in state politics in 1981 when he was appointed to the North Carolina Senate representing the 12th District. He was re-elected to that post in 1982, 1984, and 1986, and served as majority leader in 1987-88. During this time he also served as Chairman of the Appropriations/Base Budget committees, 1985-88; Chairman of the Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice committee, 1983-84; Chairman of the manufacturing and Labor Committee, 1982; and Vice Chairman of the Economic Growth and Judiciary IV Committees from 1977-1981, was a member of the North Carolina State Democratic Executive Committee from 1975-81, and served as a delegate to the Democratic National Convention.

Senator Rand was elected to the North Carolina Senate representing the 24th District in 1994, and has been re-elected twice. He has served as Chairman of Rules and Operations of the Senate from 1995-1999 and Vice Chairman of the Appropriations and Base Budget Committees during the same period. In addition to these committees, he now also serves as Vice Chairman of Information Technology and as a member of the Commerce, Finance, Insurance, Judiciary I, Justice and Public Safety, and Transportation Committees, as well as the Select Committee on Tobacco Settlement Issues. Recently, he was ranked as the second most effective legislator in the North Carolina Senate.

After graduating from Garner High School in 1957, Senator Rand earned a B.A. in Political Science at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill, followed by a J.D. from the Law School at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill. He is admitted to practice in North Carolina; U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia; United States District Courts for the Eastern, Middle, and Western Districts of North Carolina; U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit; Supreme Court of the U.S.; and is a member of the North Carolina and American Associations. Currently, he is the President of Rand & Gregory, P.A. and MedTech Investments, Inc., and is a consultant to Prime Medical Services, Inc.

Senator Rand is a strong supporter of higher education, as evidenced by his service on numerous university boards. He is a member and past chair of the General Alumni Association of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill; member and past chair of the Fayetteville State University Foundation Board of Directors; past member of the Board of Visitors, Methodist college; and a member of the Board of Directors of Fayetteville Technical Community College Foundation. He has also served on the Board of the Public School Forum of North Carolina. Other boards and organizations that Senator Rand serves include the Legislative Advisory Committee, NC Bar Association; Board of Advisors, North Carolina Academy of Physician Assistants; Board of Directors, Friends of the Museum Capital Campaign Steering Committee, NC Museum of Sciences; Board member, North Carolina Institute of Medicine; Fayetteville Chamber of Commerce; and Co-chair of the Joint Select Committee on Higher Education Facilities Needs. He is also a member and lay reader at St. John's Episcopal Church in Fayetteville.

Senator Rand is married to Karen and has two children, Ripley Eagles Rand, and Craven McLean Rand.

ACADEMIC HERALDRY

American academic attire had its origins in medieval English universities. It was devised to distinguish academic persons such as doctors, licentiates, masters and bachelors from the lay person, in that everyone wore robes or gowns to ward off the cold. The wearing of the gown, hood and cap was adopted by American colleges and universities from the English custom.

The cap, in academic dress, has the same design for all degrees. Mortarboards are generally recommended, although soft square-topped caps are permissible. The tassel that hangs from the center of the cap usually designates the field of study of the wearer. The black tassel is correct for all degrees; however, the gold tassel is worn by doctors.

The gown, unlike the cap, differs considerably in design according to the degree conferred on the wearer. The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves. It is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the masters' degree has an oblong sleeve. The sleeve base hangs down in the traditional manner. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut and the front point has an arc cutaway. The gown may be worn open or closed. The gown for the doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is faced down the front with black velvet with three bars of the same across the sleeves or these facings and crossbars may be of velvet or the color distinctive of the subject of which the degree pertains.

The hood for the bachelor's degree is three feet in length; for the master's degree, three and a half feet in length; and for the doctor's degree, four feet with panels at the sides. It is lined with the official colors of the university conferring the degree. Also, the discipline of the wearer is indicated by the colors in the hood.

THE UNIVERSITY SEAL

The current seal for Fayetteville State University was commissioned in 1989 for the installation of the university's eighth Chief Executive Officer. The seal shows, at one entrance to the university, the historic Alumni Memorial Gates, erected in 1925. Above the gates, the founding year of 1867 is prominently displayed. Between the gates is the Howard School from which the university emerged. An open book depicts the early mission of the university as a teacher preparatory institution and clasped hands inside the book symbolize unity. Within the banner is the university Motto, Res Non Verba, "Deeds, Not Words." The gates are joined at the bottom by laurels to mark the spirit of victory and pine cones to typify the North Carolina landscape. Two lamps of learning adorn the outer edges of the seal and represent the University's mission to impart learning to all who enter.

THE CHANCELLOR'S MEDALLION

The three-inch Chancellor's Medallion is a gold replica, cast in bronze, of the seal for Fayetteville State University. The medallion worn by Chancellor McLeod commemorates his installation and bears his name and the September 20, 1996, date. As part of the official academic dress for the Chancellor, it is to be worn at all ceremonial occasions.

THE UNIVERSITY MACE

Originally, the mace was modeled after war clubs carried into battle by 12th century officers. Today, it is used as a symbol of authority. Borne by the chief marshal in all university academic processions, the mace was first adopted at Fayetteville State University in 1986 and redesigned in 1989 to reflect the new seal. It was used for the first time during the 1989 Commencement exercises. The university mace is 40" in length with a cylinder-shaped head cast in hollow brass which bears the university's name, founding year and motto. Adorning the head is the university seal. Embracing the seal are laurels to mark the spirit of victory. Mounted on two sides and at the top of the cylinder are spiral rings that can be seen on the Alumni Memorial Gates. Supporting the polished brass cylinder is a 13" walnut staff tipped with a 3 ½" solid brass ball. When unattended, the mace stands in a solid walnut base.
