COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

DR. MARY FRANCES BERRY ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR EDUCATION DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND WELFARE

Dr. Mary Frances Berry, appointed Assistant Secretary for Education in the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare in 1977, was formerly the Chancellor of the University of Colorado, Boulder. She is on leave from the University, where she holds an appointment as Professor of History and Law.

Mary Berry was born in Nashville, Tennessee on February 17, 1938, and it was near Nashville that she began her formal education in a country school-house. She later completed her early education in the Nashville public school system and then went on to attend Howard University in Washington, D.C. where she earned bachelor's and master's degrees.

Continuing her graduate education at the University of Michigan, she completed her Ph.D. in history in 1966. An appointment to the faculty of the Central Michigan University as an Assistant Professor of History followed at the same time she was beginning Law School at the University of Michigan. Moving to Eastern Michigan University in 1968, she was later promoted to Associate Professor. In 1970 she joined the faculty of the University of Maryland, College Park as an Associate Professor and was an adjunct Associate Professor at the University of Michigan in 1970-71. The University of Michigan awarded her a Juris Doctor degree in 1970. Dr. Berry has been admitted to the bar in the District of Columbia.

In addition to her regular academic duties at the University of Maryland, Dr. Berry found the time for a series of government consulting positions in 1972-73 with the Office of Policy Planning at the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Office of Civil Rights at the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. She was then appointed Provost of Behavioral and Social Sciences of the University of Maryland, College Park in 1973, where she stayed until assuming the position of Chancellor of the University of Colorado, Boulder in 1976.

Dr. Berry is well known for her scholarship, having several publications to her credit, and remains active as a legal historical scholar. A member of numerous professional associations, she retains a special interest in the future of teaching and research.

The University family suffered a great loss during the academic year with the passing of Mr. John C. Jones. Dean Jones, as he was affectionately known to the University family for many years, was named Vice Chancellor for Student Development at Fayetteville State University on July 15, 1977. This appointment was approved at approximately the same time that Governor Hunt announced his appointment as a member of the State Paroles Commission. He came to Fayetteville State University in 1959 as an Associate Professor in the Department of Social Science. In 1960, he became Dean of Men and in 1965 was named Dean of Students. Prior to coming to Fayetteville State University, Dean Jones served for seven years as a Rehabilitation Counselor in the North Carolina Department of Corrections at the Raleigh and Goldsboro Youth Centers.

Dean Jones made significant contributions to civic and educational organizations in the Fayetteville area as well as in the State. He was affiliated with the Cumberland County Red Cross Board, the United Way, the Boy Scouts Council, the North Carolina Department of Youth Development, the Governor's Committee on the Study of Children and Youth, the North Carolina Advisory Board of Juvenile Correction, the Task Force for the Study of Alcoholism Among Blacks, the Cumberland County Mental Health Association, the Cumberland County Drug Commission, and the Fayetteville City Schools Advisory Board. Also, he was a Ruling Elder of the College Heights Presbyterian Church and Past Basileus of the Beta Chi Chapter of the Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.

ACADEMIC ATTIRE*

American academic attire had its origins in medieval English universities. It was devised to distinguish academic persons such as doctors, licentiates, masters and bachelors from the lay person, in that everyone wore robes or gowns to ward off the cold. The wearing of the gown, hood and cap was adopted by American colleges and universities from this English custom.

The cap, in academic dress, has the same design for all degrees. Mortarboards are generally recommended, although soft square-topped caps are permissible. The tassel that hangs from the center of the cap usually designates the field of study of the wearer. The black tassel is correct for all degrees, however the gold tassel is worn by doctors.

The gown, unlike the cap, differs considerably in design according to the degree conferred on the wearer. The gown for the Bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves. It is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the Master's degree has an oblong sleeve. The sleeve base hangs down in the traditional manner. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cut-away. The gown may be worn open or closed. The gown for the Doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is faced down the front with black velvet with three bars of the same across the sleeves: or these facings and crossbars may be of velvet of the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains.

The hood for the Bachelor's degree is three feet in length, for the Master's degree, three and a half feet in length, and for the Doctor's degree, four feet with panels at the sides. It is lined with the official colors of the university conferring the degree. Also, the discipline of the wearer is indicated by the colors in the hood.

The following is a list of colors as prescribed by the intercollegiate code to represent different disciplines in the institution:


