# COMMENCEMENT SPEAKER

**MR. THOMAS N. TODD**  
ATTORNEY-AT-LAW  
CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

MR. THOMAS N. TODD, a native of Denville, Alabama, is a practicing attorney in Chicago, Illinois.

He is an alumnus of Southern University (1959) where he earned the Bachelor of Arts Degree in Political Science. He received the Juris Doctorate in 1963 from Southern University, where he received many honors for academic excellence.

He began his career as a lawyer in 1963 in the Office of the Solicitor, United States Department of Labor. He served with the United States Army from 1964-67 in the Staff Judge Advocate General's Corp. After military service, he took a position in the Office of the U. S. Attorney in Chicago. He has also served as Executive Vice President of Operation PUSH.

Mr. Todd has been involved in many important civil rights cases. He developed the first federal criminal case against a Chicago policeman for deprivation of an individual's civil rights in 1968. He organized and established the first Civil Rights Office in a local U. S. Attorney's Office in the country in 1969. He has argued cases before the U. S. Court of Military Appeals, the U. S. Court of Appeals, the Supreme Courts of Louisiana, Illinois and the U. S. Supreme Court.

A dynamic speaker, Mr. Todd has had speaking engagements on many of the nation's college campuses, as well as on university campuses abroad. He has also been the recipient of many awards, too numerous to mention. He has been written about by many authors. His biography has been published in three major publications.

Mr. Todd is married to the former Janis Roberts and is the father of two daughters, Traci Neuborne and Tamara Nicole.

## ACADEMIC ATTIRE\*

American academic attire had its origins in medieval English universities. It was devised to distinguish academic persons such as doctors, licentiates, masters and bachelors from the lay person, in that everyone wore robes or gowns to ward off the cold. The wearing of the gown, hood and cap was adopted by American colleges and universities from this English custom.

The cap, in academic dress, has the same design for all degrees. Mortarboards are generally recommended, although soft square-topped caps are permissible. The tassel that hangs from the center of the cap usually designates the field of study of the wearer. The black tassel is correct for all degrees; however, the gold tassel is worn by doctors.

The gown, unlike the cap, differs considerably in design according to the degree conferred on the wearer. The gown for the Bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves. It is designed to be worn closed. The gown for the Master's degree has an oblong sleeve. The sleeve base hangs down in the traditional manner. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cutaway. The gown may be worn open or closed. The gown for the Doctor's degree has bell-shaped sleeves. It is faced down the front with black velvet with three bars of the same across the sleeves; or these facings and crossbars may be of velvet of the color distinctive of the subject to which the degree pertains.

The hood for the Bachelor's degree is three feet in length, for the Master's degree, three and a half feet in length, and for Doctor's degree, four feet with panels at the sides. It is lined with the official colors of the university conferring the degree. Also, the discipline of the wearer is indicated by the colors in the hood.

The following is a list of colors as prescribed by the intercollegiate code to represent different disciplines in the institution:
